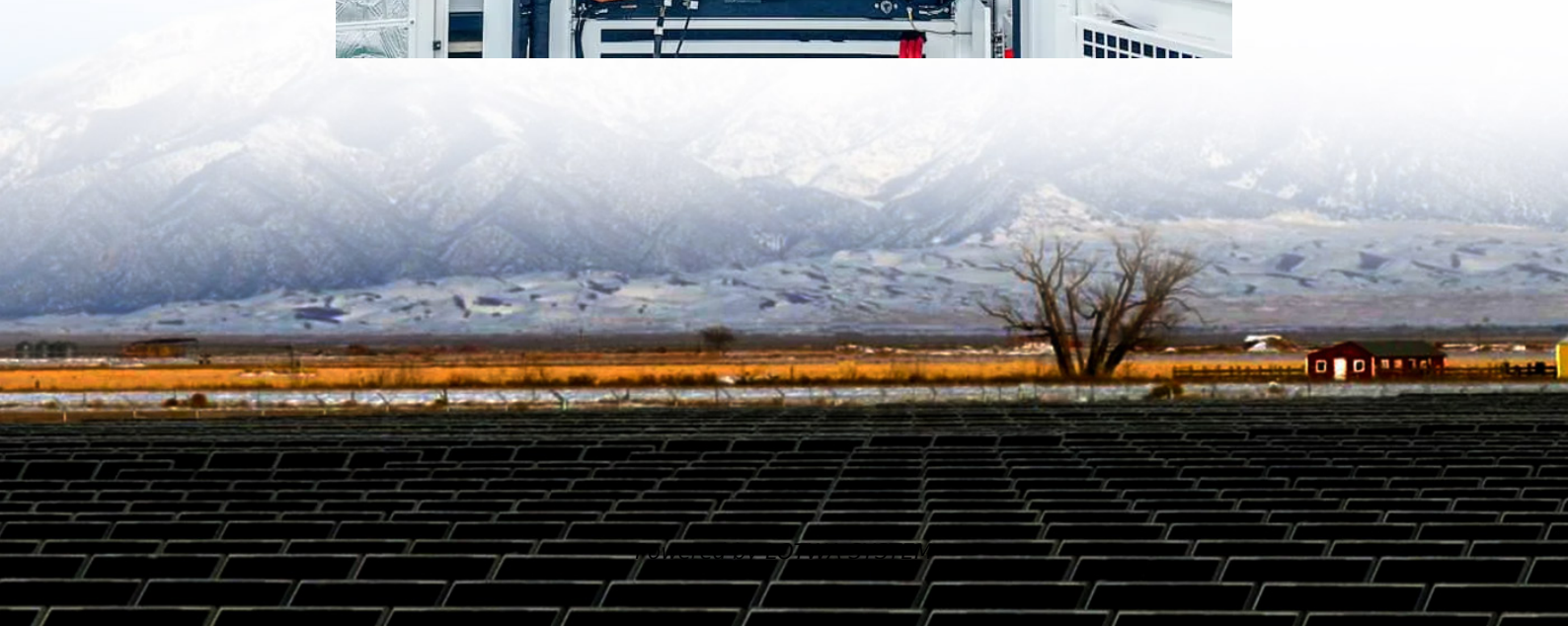


# The highest power base station in Argentina

What is Argentina's most famous coal-fired power plant?

Argentina's most notable coal-fired power plant is the 375-megawatt (MW) San Nicolás power station located in Buenos Aires. The plant was commissioned in 1983 and is scheduled to be retired in 2026. Argentina's most recent project is the 240-MW Río Turbio plant, which has two 120-MW units. The plant sources coal from the Río Turbio coal mine.

How many power plants are there in Argentina?

Does Argentina have nuclear power?

Argentina is one of the few countries in Central America and South America with nuclear power, contributing about 5.2% to the electricity mix in 2022. As of 2023, Argentina had three operational nuclear power plants, Atucha I, Atucha II, and Embalse, with a total capacity of 1,763 MW of electricity.
